The Structural Engineering Institute (SEI) of the ASCE East Central Branch (ECB) is proud to announce the ASCE ECB SEI Scholarship. This scholarship is part of the SEI commitment to support Central Florida's brightest minds for future careers in structural engineering.

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to full time students with interest in structural engineering field. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Currently registered full-time student majoring in Civil/Structural Engineering at a University within the ECB region.
- Is an active member of his/her local ASCE student chapter.
- Is currently in a good academic standing (G.P.A 3.0 or higher).

Application Requirements

The following documents must be submitted along with the Scholarship Application Form no later than July 31, 2025, for eligibility:

- Short video essay about your interest and the importance of structural engineering. The video essay must be presented by you in approximately 3 minutes or less.
- Unofficial school transcripts
- Three (3) references with names and phone numbers or e-mails (examples: faculty, employers, co-workers, ASCE Student Chapter Officer).

Evaluation criteria

Applicants will be scored based on the following:

- Recorded video essay
- GPA
- References
- Involvement with ASCE Chapter/community
- Feedback from reference

Application process

Applicants shall submit a complete application package to <u>asce.ecb.sei@gmail.com</u> in PDF format and with a link to YouTube video essay (or similar) no later than **July 31, 2025**. Other submission methods, incomplete applications, or late applications will not be accepted.

Amount of Scholarship

The ASCE ECB SEI will award one scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 to an eligible student currently pursuing a career in civil/structural engineering field.
